



Using Nikhef home and project folders on the go


To mount your Nikhef home or project directories, after having established your eduVPN Institute Access connection, open an Explorer window and select "Map network drive":




in the dialog box, select a free drive letter (for example "N:" for Nikhef) and type the UNC network path. Be sure to select "Connect using different credentials" so that you can enter your Nikhef login username and password:




Enter your Nikhef username with "NIKHEF\" in front of it, and give your passphrase. For additional security, leave "Remember my credentials" **UN**checked, unless you have full disk encryption (BitLocker) enabled:






Wait for this window to disappear:



The additional drive now shows up in your explorer window and can be used!




The same can be done for project and wproject directories. You can use any free drive letter to add the ones in addition to the current one (and will not have to provide your credentials again).

To unmount and disconnect the remote drives once you are done, use "disconnect network drive" from the network drive menu button, or use the context menu (right-click) of the virtual drive:
